Shubhneet Warar

Shubhneet Warar is the eldest daughter of Manjit and Seema Warar and has maintained a 4.8 weighted grade point average and straight A's throughout her years at Caddo Parish Magnet High School in Shreveport, Louisiana. Earning the highest score of five on three advanced placement exams, she has received the AP Scholar with Honor distinction.

Warar is the president of her mock trial team, has earned first place in regional victories for the past two years and has received awards as Best Witness and Best Lawyer. This year, her team won the state championship and will go on to compete at the national level in Connecticut. Earlier this year, they placed fourth at the National Empire Mock Trial Competition in Georgia. She also helped to start a middle school mock trial camp to encourage an interest in law with youths.

While carrying out duties for the National Honor Society, student council, National Spanish Honor Society, Mu Alpha Theta, Science Olympiad and the National Society of High School Scholars, Shubhneet finds time to play volleyball and the bassoon. After writing a humorous poem called "Ode to the Platypus" to show the value of an uncommon species, she won an Artbreak Literary

Award and was published in Caddo Parish's *Seedlings Magazine*.

Warar values giving back to her community and has been a volunteer prosecuting attorney with Teen Court, a STEM proponent for SciPort and Camp Invention summer camps as well as a math tutor for her school's Homework Gang and the Association for the Blind. With over 300 service hours, she was named as her school's Prudential Spirit of Community Award winner. She is also the service coordinator for her Key Club and participated in a backpack drive to give kids in her community much needed school supplies.

In the fall, Shubhneet Warar will attend Baylor University while double majoring in mathematics and chemistry and plans to join the collegiate mock trial team. After attending medical school, she hopes to pursue her dream of becoming an orthopedics physician.
